APPLICATION PROCESS

FULLY REFEREED PAPERS (OPTIONAL)

Full paper refereeing for the Conference edition of the Australian Journal of Career Development is optional. For this purpose the full paper needs to be submitted by December 31st 2007 for refereeing. It will assist if authors restrict their names and institution contact details to a removable title page. Papers should follow the publication guidelines of the Australian Journal of Career Development. Authors will receive notification by email of the acceptance or rejection of their paper by 31st January 2008.
